Holders of H shares and domestic shares whose names appear on the register of members of the Company on 24 September 2026 (Thursday) are entitled to attend and vote at this meeting. If the shareholder is a corporation, that instrument must be executed either under its common seal or under the hand of its director(s) or duly authorised attorney. If that instrument is signed by an attorney of the shareholder, the power of attorney authorising that attorney to sign or other authorisation document must be notarised.
